GUIDELINES:

CANDIDATES MUST:

- Be a student in Duval County Public Schools or a Duval County resident in grades 6–8.
- Be able to express themselves in front of large groups and cameras.

TIMELINE:

Deadline to submit an essay is 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 26, 2019.

Winners will be announced on Friday, May 3, 2019.

Winners, their families and their school representatives will attend Kickoff Breakfast on Monday, May 13, 2019.

All essays become the property of Family Foundations and the Eighth Annual Wi\$e Money Week Committee and may be used to promote financial literacy.

TO APPLY

- Students must have parent or guardian permission to apply and participate.
- Students must write an essay (300 words or less) answering the 2019 Question.
- The essay must be the original work of the student submitting the essay.
